What are we missing?

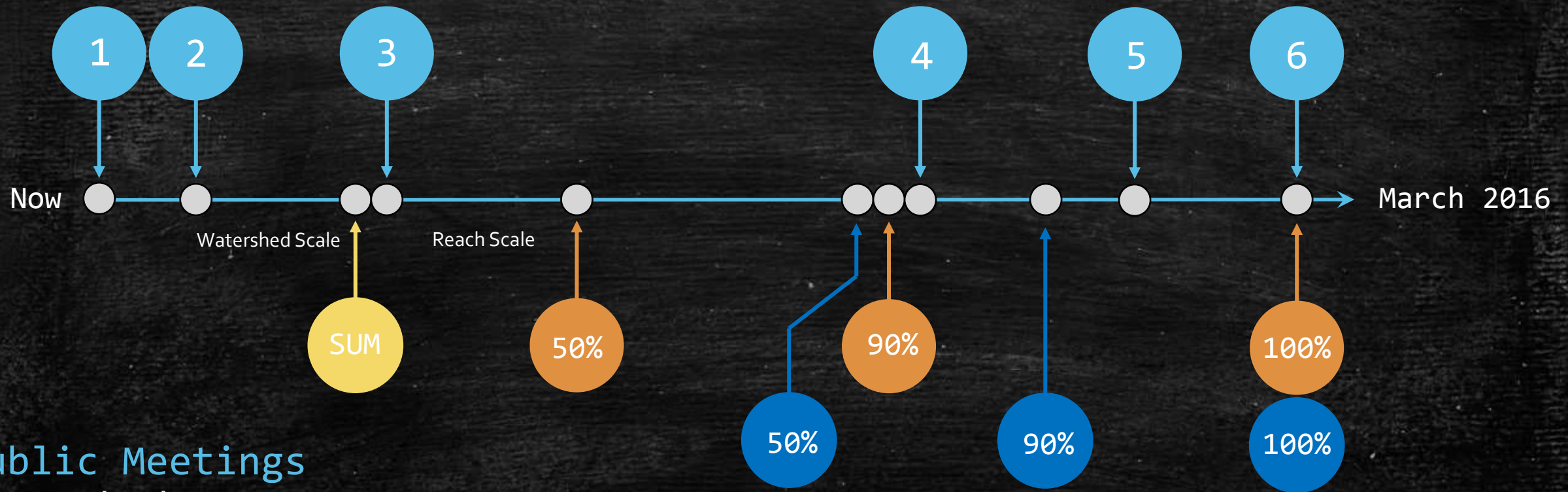
The Action Plan:
